



In 2018, Michigan Gateway Community Foundation implemented a new program in Buchanan, called The Buchanan Promise Children's Saving Account Kickstart To Career or (BK2C). The BK2C Program is one of only 15 Children's Saving Account Programs in Michigan and we are lucky to have it here in Buchanan. Every school year, Buchanan Kindergarten students are issued a \$50 savings account at Honor Credit Union. These are deposit only accounts intended for post-secondary education expenses. The foundation and its donors will add incentive deposits over the years and students and their families are encouraged to make deposits as well. The program also consists of financial literacy and career readiness taught to the students. This wonderful program is a partnership with Buchanan Community Schools, Honor Credit Union and the Buchanan Promise and I am thrilled to watch it grow!

BUCHANAN PROMISE

2021 marked the first-year inaugural scholarship recipients of the Buchanan Promise graduated from four-year colleges and universities so it is time to celebrate their accomplishments and educational journeys. The Buchanan Promise, a post-secondary education scholarship program provided first awards to the BHS Class of 2017. As of 2022, students living and attending Buchanan Community Schools since kindergarten receive 100% which is \$3,750 a year for a total of \$15,000. Graduates who have lived in district and attended Buchanan Community Schools for a minimum of four years qualify for 70% of the award with a sliding scale for those in-between. The Buchanan Promise was established in 2016 with an endowment fund created by Walter E. Schirmer Jr. Highlighted in one of the new video series titled "Promise Fulfilled," Alex Tobler reflected on her recent 2021 graduation from Adrian College with a degree in accounting. "If I wouldn't have had the Promise, I would have had to take out loans in the amount I got for the Promise, so I am very grateful," she said. I am delighted to see the accomplishments of the students and am proud to know that the Promise program has helped students accomplish their goals of obtaining a meaningful career.
